Salem Quarterly Meeting Religious Society of Friends Education Fund Scholarship

Guidelines

It is the mission of the Salem Quarter Education Fund Committee to provide grants for the education of the members of Salem Quarterly Meeting and their children. The Education Fund is used for scholarships to colleges and Quaker schools Pre-K through 12th grade.

Eligibility

The applicants (or applicants' families) must be active members in good standing of a monthly meeting in Salem Quarter. SQ Meetings include Greenwich, Mickleton, Mullica Hill, Salem, Seaville, Woodbury, and Woodstown. Friends applying for aid in Pre-K through 12th grade must be applying to a Friends school. Friends applying for college aid do not have to be applying to Quaker schools.

Application Process

- 1. The attached application form should be printed out and completed by the applicant (or applicant's family), then given to their **monthly meeting clerk** for certification signature.
- 2. The monthly meeting clerk should forward the completed application to the clerk of the SQ Education Fund Committee, Abigaile Brace-Higgins.
- 3. The application form must be submitted by **February 15th**. Late applications will not be eligible for consideration.

Award Determination and Distribution

The SQ Education Fund Committee's budget has a limited amount of funds to distribute each year. Grant amounts depend on available funds and the number of applicants. Award notifications will be sent in late summer. Grants for Pre-K through 12th grade students will be sent directly to the Quaker schools. College students' grants will be sent to their home mailing addresses.
